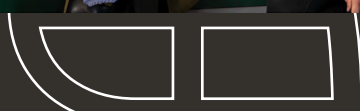
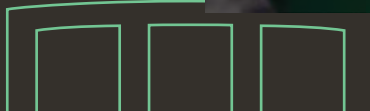

university. In its relatively short history (since 1997), the university has produced a number of successful graduates who are proof of its quality.

Currently, it provides education at 5 faculties and 1 institute.

It is a modern educational institution that is characterized by its uniqueness, offers diverse study programs, develops science and research in the humanities, social and natural sciences, cooperates with foreign university workplaces and institutions and has good ties with the business background of the region and the whole Slovakia. Thanks to its wide offer, the application of modern educational methods, the excellent equipment of the classrooms and the friendly attitude of the teachers, it has a stable interest of applicants for studies.



Our university responds systematically to changes in the national and international environment, flexibly adapts the content, form and methods of education to these changes, and is therefore rightfully considered a modern university.

Any student who is interested and meets the specified conditions can spend some time abroad as part of the Erasmus+ program at one of more than 115 partner universities. The university is also extremely successful in obtaining grants for mobility to countries outside the European Union.

University history

University of Ss. Cyril and Methodius in Trnava was established by Act No. 201/1997 Coll. and reflected on society's need to develop higher education in the 90s of the last century. For the Slovak academic community and especially for the Trnava region, the establishment of the UCM in Trnava was of immense importance. In addition to facilitating access to higher education for hundreds of students and the related increase in education and culture in the region, the university has since its inception supported and aided the development of science and education in Slovakia through the realization of fields of study that until then had been in the background. At the same time it opened up space for the creation of new, modern study programs.

As the only university in Slovakia at that time, it allowed students to study programs in mass media and marketing communication, thus gaining a stamp of uniqueness. To date, it has educated more than **18,000 graduates in all 3 levels of education.**

The bill by which the university was established was based on the concept of Christian traditions that influenced the city of Trnava. The university was thus gradually formed in the spirit of the democratic, Christian and national values and ideals declared in the law, while its graduates are destined to develop Slovak science, culture and education in line with national, European and world heritage.

A wide spectrum of study programs (biology, chemistry, applied informatics, protection and restoration of the environment) enables graduates to apply in a wide range of workplaces and laboratories with a biological, chemical, pharmaceutical, health focus, in research teams (SAV, universities, health departments, agriculture and forestry, food industry, environment, etc.) also in environmentally/ecologically oriented workplaces. They can also be used in state and local government institutions and in private companies with a research-technological orientation. They will also be employed as pharmaceutical representatives, workers in biochemical and synthetic laboratories, environmental, waste, pedagogical, or scientific workers at universities, such as professional inspection, measurement



and monitoring of analytical characteristics of individual components of the environment, application of remedial (sanitation) technologies. Graduates of the applied informatics study program will find employment in computing and IT departments located in production institutions, research and development workplaces, the corporate sphere, in public and state administration, in finance and insurance, as programmers, administrators of web multidisciplinary applications, as administrators of computer applications and networks.

Employment of graduates in practice

A graduate of the study program Physiotherapy masters the basic examination and treatment procedures and methods in physiotherapy, balneology and therapeutic rehabilitation, in



primary, secondary and subsequent health care, counseling and educational activities. Graduates carry out their highly professional activities within the framework of preventive, diagnostic, curative and rehabilitation care in medical and spa facilities, in social care institutions, in rehabilitation institutions, in sanatoriums, in home nursing care agencies, in workplaces focusing on therapeutic



physical education, physical therapy and complex physiotherapy, as well as modern rehabilitative-recreational and preventive facilities such as wellness / fitness, which are increasingly sought after nowadays.

Physiotherapy graduates can also work in other specialized workplaces, such as health and commercial insurance companies and employment offices. In addition, they can also be used in educational facilities for disabled children and youth, retraining facilities for disabled citizens, sheltered workshops, and occupational therapy workplaces. They can also work in social organizations that aim to resocialize disabled citizens. They can also be used in facilities that manufacture and distribute aids for the field of physiotherapy.

A graduate of the Radiological Technology study program will perform highly professional activities within the framework of diagnostic and treatment care in inpatient and outpatient diagnostic and treatment facilities, medical institutions, research institutes and other health institutions with nationwide scope, not excluding veterinary medicine workplaces. It can also work in specialized workplaces such as health insurance companies and public health offices and in companies engaged in the production of radiodiagnostic and therapeutic devices.

At the same time, students will also get an answer to the most important question: Do I enjoy and fulfill this work enough to dedicate myself to it in my professional career? The study program management in tourism and hotel industry helps to fulfill the strategic objective of tourism development in Slovakia by providing qualified managers in this area. As part of the study, students will also gain knowledge and practical



skills in terms of introducing their own projects into of life (Clothes Swap at „Baterkáreň“, Book Swap at „Podivný Barón“ in Púchov, Coffee stop, Traveller's talk, TOP excursion at „Hotel pod Lipou“ and many others...) and check whether the idea has meaning and can come to life and be successful.

International Relations and Internationalization Strategy

University of Ss. Cyril and Methodius in Trnava (UCM) has been constantly expanding international contacts with important world and European educational institutions, organizations and other partners in the field of science, research and education since its establishment. We perceive internationalization as one of the preconditions for increasing the quality of higher education as an important tool for the exchange of experience, the development of language and intercultural skills of students and university staff.

The development of international cooperation at the university is implemented primarily in the form of bilateral and multilateral agreements aimed at the mutual exchange of students, teaching and non-teaching staff, as well as through the implementation of international scientific projects, the organization of joint scientific events and the presentation



of work results in the form of joint publications.

Students and employees can take advantage of a wide range of mobilities through the Erasmus+ program or they can complete a stay abroad on the basis of other international bilateral agreements, or take advantage of opportunities within other mobility and scholarship schemes and programs.

The most widespread and successful are Erasmus+ and CEEPUS programs. It is a program of the European Union that provides grants for a wide range

of actions and activities in the field of education, vocational training, youth and sports.

The aim of the program in the field of higher education is to support mutual cooperation in the European and non-European areas, to increase the level of transparency and compatibility of higher education qualifications in Europe, to improve the quality of language teaching and to contribute to the improvement of the quality of the European education system.

Study stays within the ERASMUS+ program allow travel to 28 EU member states (Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Greece, Netherlands, Croatia, Ireland, Lithuania, Latvia, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, Germany, Poland, Portugal, Austria, Romania, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Italy, Great Britain), as well as countries of the European Economic Area (Norway, Iceland,

Liechtenstein), Turkey and Macedonia.

Another option is to travel as part of the Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility (ICM) program or NSP.

UCM is particularly successful in this program within Slovak universities, so our teachers and students also travel to Algeria, Indonesia, Iraq, Mexico, Malaysia, Kosovo, Tanzania and many other non-European countries.

In addition to the travel of our students and employees, it is through this program that our university is authorized to accept foreign students and employees, which contributes to the variety and quality of studies.

Part of supporting the development of international relations is also receiving foreign visits, delegations, lecturers and experts, which enrich the teaching process and contribute to the internationalization of science, research and education at our university.

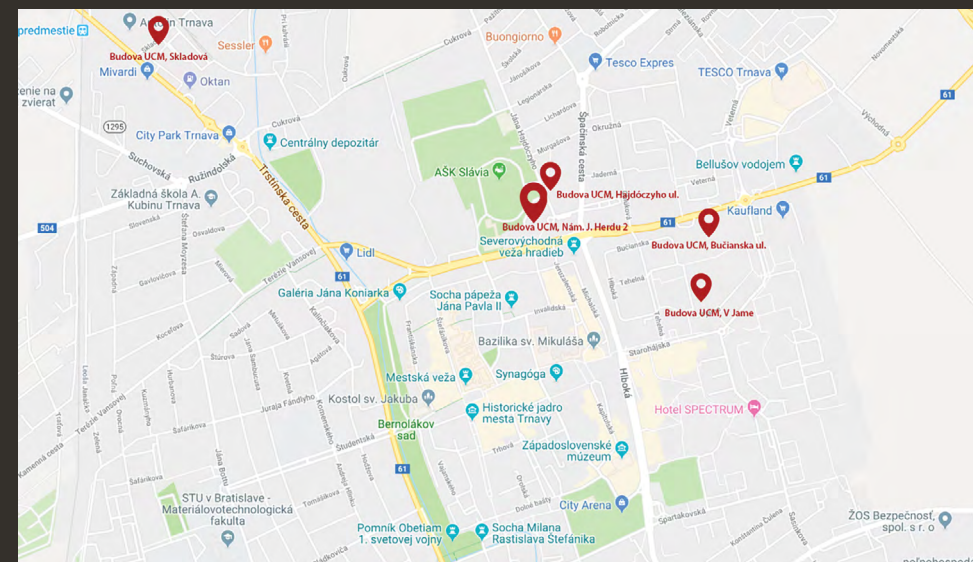
