Admission requirements for the Master's degree programme:

The basic requirement for admission to the second cycle degree programme is the completion of the first cycle degree programme, in accordance with Article 56 Section 2 of Law No. 131 on Higher Education.

The application includes a curriculum vitae, a medical fitness certificate, and an entrance examination fee payment receipt.

Further, the graduates of study programmes will attach a higher education diploma, a certificate of the state examination, and a diploma supplement. The graduates of Bachelor's degree programmes will attach a certificate of examinations and credits. In both cases, the applicants will submit certified copies or original documents.

In the procedure of admission to the Master's degree programme, the results of the Bachelor's studies are taken into consideration. In the case of graduation from the Bachelor's degree programme in the related fields of study, the Admission Commission at the Faculty of Natural Sciences can require carrying out the entrance examinations.
